

Directions for Isabelle and finishing the quilt.

1. Make the attic window block.
2. Prepare all appliques. Position and fuse appliques #1, 2, and 3.
3. Using yellow or gold thread stitch a V shaped line for Isabelle's necklace chain. Sitich over this line a second time to make it heavier.
4. Position remaining appliques. Fuse in place and edge stitch.
5. Satin stitch her smile.

Finishing: Square all the blocks to 10-1/2" x 10-1/2". The window strips should be 2-1/4" wide and be bear backgrounds shoud be 8-1/2" x 8-1/4".

Cut 8 - 1-1/2" x WOF strips of the black fabric for block sashing.

Cut 6 - 10-1/2" pieces from 2 of the strips. Stitch them to the right side of blocks 1, 2, 4, 5, 7, and 8.

Finish Robert and Ned.

Stitch the blocks into rows.

Measure the row length and stitch a sashing piece between rows 1 and 2. Finish Willy by positioning his head, inner ears, eyes and nose. Fuse in place and edge stitch. Satin stitch his smile.

Add the sashing strip between rows 2 and 3. Sew this row to rows 1 nd 2. Sew sashing strips to the ouside edges of the quilt.

From the 4-1/2" strips of background fabrics cut 4-1/2" squares and 4-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles. Measure the quilt top and piece the squares and rectangles together in a random order to make the outside borders. Some trimming will be necessary.

Layer and quilt as desired.

Piece the 2-1/2" x 22 strips of background fabrics randomly for the binding.
